2. Call for Additional Business

- Fr. Nick added the Chicken BBQ to the Agenda.
- Amy Heist added the 4th of July Parade to the Agenda.

3. Review/Acceptance of May Minutes

- Fr. Nick asked if there were additions or corrections to the minutes of the May 18, 2023 meeting, and none were stated.
- Pete Schlau motioned to accept the May minutes as written, and Amy Heist seconded the motion. The minutes were accepted by a unanimous vote.

4. Review/Acceptance of May Financial Report – *from Mike Somer

a) State of the Capital Drive

- i. Pavilion Update This project is completed, and the certificate of occupancy has arrived. The current electricity package has been completed as well. There will be a quote for further electrical work.
- ii. Pavilion Work Recognition/Opening Ceremony This service will take place on July 2 at 9am outside under the pavilion. The Vestry also discussed recognition for volunteers and donors possibly taking place at a later time.
- Pavilion Use Policy Fr. Nick contacted Church Insurance to see if we need to add the iii. Pavilion to our policy. The Vestry discussed logistics and Fr. Nick will follow up with other churches who also have a pavilion and see what their policies are. The Vestry also discussed

- AA using the space. Amy Heist motioned to allow AA to utilize the pavilion after the opening ceremony on July 2, and Allie Porter seconded the motion. The motion passed by a unanimous vote.
- iv. <u>Church Roof Replacement Options</u> The Vestry discussed moving forward with how to choose the color for the roof. Carol Northrup motioned to choose black for the color of the church roof, and Amy Heist seconded the motion. The motion passed by a unanimous vote. The Vestry added that the timeline of this project depends on the availability of Jeff Miller.

b) Chicken BBQ

 Pete Schlau stated that there are no major issues this year, but the sales for the Shea's tickets have been slow so far. Pete also stated that they are in need of volunteers, and the signup sheet is posted.

c) Pet Pantry Proposal

• Fr. Nick stated that no decision has been made yet, and that space was the issue delaying the decision. The Vestry discussed possibly offering space on a "trial basis." Fr. Nick will reach out to the committee.
